Chart Patterns

Tripod

You have the planetary pattern known as the 'tripod' shape. With your planets divided into three distinct groups, your personality tends to exhibit a considerable degree of selfsufficiency. You have the same characteristics as a Grand Trine personality type.

T-Square, focal planet Mars

You have a T-Square in your chart. With a this planetary aspect pattern, in which three planets or conjunctions are in square with one another, you have a high degree of motivation and drive. Your energies are most easily and habitually expressed by the energy of the focal point, the middle of the T-Square. You may also compensate for overdoing in the area of life represented by the focal point, by leaning toward the empty pattern element opposite the focal point, seeking to balance your activity. The lesson of this planetary aspect pattern is in learning to use your considerable energy wisely in the pursuit of your true goals. There is great tension represented by the focal planet or planets in your chart, where conflicting parts of your personality attain their focus and peak of energy, and you may observe compulsive behavior in the area of life represented here.

Mars in the Ninth House (or sign) gives a friendly and optimistic nature. You are likely to lead a physically active life, and are fond of sports and gambling. You are idealistic, outspoken and honest with your opinions. You are also likely to be spontaneous and even a bit impulsive. You can be scattered in the application of your energies, and it will perhaps benefit you to work at becoming more reliable. You have a great propensity for learning. Your energy is most naturally invested in adventures of the higher mind: travel, education, perhaps publishing. You like many different pursuits, and have a kind of haphazard way of going about things that can get you into trouble. You may tend to miss the details, by fixing your gaze on "the big picture." You also can be dogmatic at times, when you get too carried away with your own point of view. You profit by learning to slow down your enthusiasm and focus your concentration on reachable goals.

Mars in Taurus (or the second house) gives a persistent and patient nature. You can be extremely stubborn. You can also be jealous and possessive. You value money and other forms of security. You possess an enthusiasm for the pursuit of sensual pleasures. You are likely to be an ardent and loyal lover. You enjoy the good things of life. You may find that you have a desire for luxuries, but lack the conservative attitude toward finances that would help to secure them. If Mars is afflicted in your chart by planetary aspect, you may need to work through pride and acquisitiveness in your nature, or there could be problems with possessiveness, or even resentments towards others. You have an artistic flair to your nature, and function well in the realm of the material and tangible world, with the stamina required to get what you want out of life. You benefit from cultivating an attitude of sharing.

Important Features

Mercury in Virgo (5° Vir 39'R) Mercury in the Twelfth House Ruler of rising sign

Mercury in Virgo gives an analytical and practical mentality, with great powers of logic and reason. Other people find you dependable and know that they can rely on your thought process. Your common sense is strong, and you tend to think things through. You reason well, and speak clearly and honestly, although you can also be intolerant, or may speak critically about people who do not measure up to your standards. You are at times almost too analytical, tending to see everything in terms of categories. Your attention to detail may prevent you from focusing on the larger picture. You are quick to learn but you may need to work to develop your concentration and your retention of the knowledge you have gained. It also benefits you to zoom out once in a while, and take in the bigger picture.

Mercury in the Twelfth House represents a strong mental connection between your inner awareness and the deep and nebulous realms of magical inner worlds. You have a refined and visionary mentality. With this placement, you are likely to be poetic in the expression of your thoughts and feelings, and you may possess musical ability as well. You are fascinated by the unknowable mysteries of your own inner world, and you are inclined to search to the depths in order to understand yourself. Mundane reality doesn't interest you. You may avoid dealing with it by being evasive or vague in your communication with others, or by daydreaming, or by falling prey to a form of self-deception. You also may have issues of whose thoughts you are responding to, yours or another's. You may have difficulty in communicating the results of your inner explorations with others. However, once you have sorted through your most awesome and perhaps even fearsome inner experiences, you are better able to connect with those who find a similar numinous connection with the cosmos.

Pluto in Virgo (1° Vir 43') - Pluto in the Twelfth House Angular planet - conjunct Ascendant

Pluto in the Twelfth House (or sign) gives a "divine discontent" to the personality. With this placement, you may feel confined and limited in the physical world, perhaps feeling more at home in the world of unconscious fantasy. There may be a way that you are not accepting your own power. You may compulsively try to escape the physical plane of existence, by whatever means come readily to you, especially if Pluto is poorly aspected in your chart. In any case you are likely to feel preoccupied with your own inner world, or may find yourself so sensitive to the pain and suffering of others that you retreat from fully involving yourself with them. There are places within yourself where you fear to tread, and the danger is that you deny an important part of yourself in the process. You have a deep need for spiritual renewal that does not easily find its resolution in everyday activity. You may experience confusion and a loss of identity until you make an effort to move toward a more universal sense of self, learning to subordinate your personal will to a more spiritual outlook based on the true needs of others and the life of the world around you.

The following applies to your generation as a whole as well as to you personally: Pluto in Virgo (or the sixth house) gives you an intense desire to be of service in the world. This desire can take the form of a compulsion to help others in a way that may not truly be appreciated by the intended beneficiaries. You are slightly obsessed with finding the purity inherent in human activity, and may well be a champion of the environmental movement, or exert yourself strenuously in your job or home setting. You may also become intensely concerned and perhaps even chronically worried over health issues, or you may be apt to stress over organizational detail where the intention is to purify the function of the particular activity, but where attending to the details can become an end in itself. You may go through many profound changes of attitude in these areas, in order to learn how to be of actual service to yourself and others. Creative outlets for your passion might be found in the helping professions, or in working on your own issues in such a way as to regenerate your values and life direction. When you have transformed in these areas you can become a beacon for others to follow. By staying true to your own inner guidance system, you make it possible for others to also, and further the cause of a more self-aware and wisely functioning planetary society.

Neptune in Scorpio (2° Sco 18') - Neptune in the Third House

Neptune in the Third House (or sign) gives a clever personality with subtle charm. You are witty and poetic. You are fond of higher education, but you tend to be a dreamer and may miss out on serious study because of it. You see the world through the mystical third eye, rather than the usual binocular setup that allows most people to get along. Because of your extraordinary visionary viewpoint you may see more than others and also miss out on some of the mundane details. You may suffer some confusion regarding communication received, or perhaps where close relatives are concerned, or have feelings of insecurity stemming from your early years, that carry over into adult life. You can be indecisive and worrisome but you are also broad-minded and mentally creative. It benefits you to learn to focus your considerable creative potential, and to let yourself become a channel for higher forms of thought to flow into your own life, and through you into the world around you.

The following applies to your generation as a whole as well as to you personally:

Neptune in Scorpio (or the eighth house) gives an individual with great personal magnetism. You have a subtle intuition and an unusually clear insight into the motivations of others. You also may unconsciously try to control other people, or act in somewhat unreliable ways. You have an ideal of self-sacrifice in partnership with others, and tend to give more than you receive, which can lead in the end to resentment on your part, or just disappearing. Moon in Virgo (11° Vir 33') - Moon in the First House Angular planet - conjunct Ascendant

The Moon in Virgo gives a hardworking and well-organized personality. You may appear somewhat reserved. You may appear fussy and overly critical of others, due to a streak of perfectionism in your innermost being. You truly are of service to other people, and you are likely to be well-regarded because of it. You may have a sense of insecurity that underlies your drive for intellectual superiority. You should beware of attempting to change other people for the better, and you should be easier on yourself and others to avoid problems with your health in later life.

The Moon in the First House represents the emotional, sensitive, experience of self-image projected onto the world. Your identity in the world depends on your environment and you will reflect the environment around you in an emotional or sensitive way. You are likely to possess a strong imagination. You may be moody. You are comfortable when you are in action. You may feel a need to be recognized and may feel resentful if others around you do not perceive your efforts. You are flexible and concerned about interacting with your environment in a refined, considerate, and observant manner. You may need to recognize that others are not as sensitive as you are and may not always be capable of appreciating your receptive and intuitive qualities.

Angular Planets

Sun, Moon, Rising Sign Features

Sun in Leo (23° Leo 07') - Sun in the Twelfth House Ruler of sun sign - sun's ruler

The Sun represents your will and purpose, your sense of vitality, and your evolving higher Self. In Leo it is Fixed-Fire, and rules the heart and spine. Your ruling planet is the Sun itself, and you are likely to express yourself in dramatic, creative and assertive ways. You are also likely to enjoy the warmth of the physical Sun. You have great energy, courage and honesty. You are likely to be self-confident and maybe even a bit self-indulgent. You expect to be the center of attention, and often are. You can be quite determined and usually get your way when you really want to. You also possess great integrity, and are a natural leader. Leo people are very proud. Your challenge is to temper any tendency for arrogant or egotistical behavior and to instead develop humility and compassion; to learn detachment in the gift of your affections, so that you radiate your abundant energy freely and enhance the life experience of others around you.

The Sun in Twelfth House represents a concentration of the vital force to be one with the unifying forces of cosmic awareness. You are intuitively aware that you are within the source of creation. You likely identify yourself with formlessness, being more attracted to awareness itself than to any particular concrete form within it. You sense that you are more than merely a body with feelings, emotions, and thoughts. You may in fact reject your own boundaries because you cannot identify with any self as being separate from the universal cosmic self, or God(dess). Conversely, you may be frustrated and feel alienated from the source, and may have a tendency to seek out substitute highs in an effort to achieve the sense of oneness you know to be true. Due to your lack of personal

boundaries you are quite sensitive to the collective unconscious as an interior realm of perception. You perceive reality as forms of creation and therefore are naturally inclined to the artistic, poetic, or musical. Your sensitivity can create a need for you to periodically withdraw in order to cleanse yourself of psychic debris you've pick up in the outside world. You benefit from such retreats in order to come back to yourself, and create positive boundaries of selfhood that allow you to re-enter the collective awareness with clarity and fresh perceptions that can stimulate others to clarify their own purpose for themselves as well.

Sun in strong sextile - (within 3.3 degrees) with Jupiter

The planetary energies flow together, open into new possibilities, new connections. This aspect gives an optimistic and generous individual, with good spirits and abundant energy. You are quietly spiritual in your approach to life. You also have good executive abilities, and make a capable leader. You are fortunate materially, and have simple tastes, so that your wants are few and easily satisfied. Good fortune follows you through life.

Sun in strong opposition (within 3.1 degrees) with Chiron

The planetary energies are polarized; outer events stimulate their interaction; integration is the challenge.

With this aspect between Sun and Chiron you are likely to experience painful realizations throughout your own life and also have the ability to heal others as well. Chiron is called "the wounded healer" because it represents the archetype of imperfection and loss which when integrated leads to compassion and understanding of others' suffering. The empathy and the understanding that are gained through life's trials provide the ability to serve as a helper and a healer for others. You are more invested in this archetype than most, since it is in a powerful connection with your Sun, representing your conscious self. You have undoubtedly experienced pain and frustration related to your self-concept, perhaps through your relationship with your father or the same-sex parent. There could have been trauma in your early years concerning your parenting or the parental protection that may have been withdrawn too suddenly or misapplied. You may have suffered actual abuse in childhood or perhaps in later years such as in the period of adolescence, when you needed to make the transition to your own adulthood and may have been prevented from fully emerging into a more responsible and complete state due to external circumstances or your own lack or self-confidence. Since you have come through the fires of difficulty you are likely to be someone with career possibilities in the helping professions. Then you will be in a position to truly sympathize with others' suffering and help them to work out their traumas as well.

Sun in trine (within 4.0 degrees) with Saturn

The planetary energies flow smoothly; the connection is easy and beneficial.

This aspect gives a deepening and concentration of your self-expression. You can be strong-willed and determined, and can appear selfish, or cautious and reserved. You have a strong desire for recognition. In later years you will probably acquire a firm basis for respect in terms of accomplishments over a lifetime of careful and industrious effort. The

lesson for you is to deepen and broaden the knowledge of who you really are at the level of your innermost soul, and to really learn to love the person that you find in this process.

Moon in strong conjunction (within 3.3 degrees) with Ascendant

The strongest blend of the energies represented by these two planets.

The conjunction between the Moon and Ascendant gives a nurturing and protective personality. Like Cancer rising people you are subtle in your actions, rather than direct, and are likely to reflect the moods of those around you. Security and your home are important to you. You wear your heart on your sleeve, showing your emotions more readily than most. You also have a habit of moodiness, with your emotions frequently changing, or you could tend to be passive, preferring to immerse yourself in your feelings. You tend to collect the residue of past experience and hold onto it, as a coloration of present activities. This leads to instinctual rather than conscious action, and you can therefore benefit from shedding the light of conscious reason on your habitual patterns, and working toward greater focus on your true individual goals.

Moon in conjunction (within 5.9 degrees) with Mercury

Ruler of rising sign

The strongest blend of the energies represented by these two planets.

This conjunction gives a sensible, kindly personality with a shrewd and penetrating understanding. You are honest, straight talking and logical, and display an unusually high intelligence. With your powerful mind and fertile imagination, you are known for being witty and entertaining. You are also a bit whimsical and you have unusual ideas. You are likely to be extra careful with your health.

Moon in trine (within 3.8 degrees) with Mars

The planetary energies flow smoothly; the connection is easy and beneficial.

This aspect gives a vigorous and daring personality. You are out-going, and may also be a profound thinker. You have a practical and matter-of-fact way of going about things. You speak directly and to the point, although you may be over-sensitive to criticism. All in all, you have good control over your passions and balance well between the extremes of getting close to other people and maintaining your own sense of individuality.

Moon in semi-square (within 0.2 degrees) with Jupiter

The planetary energies conflict in determined subtle tension; calmness is required. This aspect gives an optimistic and kindly personality. You are tolerant of others, and enjoy good company as well as good food. You are likely to be fortunate in finances, and attract material rewards without seeming to try for them. You are usually able to spend money as fast as you get it, so you don't usually pile up riches. You should beware of a tendency to over-indulge.

Moon in semi-sextile (within 1.2 degrees) with Uranus

The planetary energies attract each other, require effort, allow entry of new information. This aspect gives an eccentric personality with volatile emotions and with a strong sense of intuition. You have changeable emotions, and may appear unpredictable, at times, to other people. Novelty excites you. You may change your residence frequently, or go through fundamental transformations of identity in your life, and you may feel stifled if these impulses are not allowed expression. You can benefit from learning to balance your needs for security with your urge for freedom and experimentation.

Virgo Rising

The Rising Sign is the mask shown to others, also the physical appearance.

Virgo rising people are very conscious of details. You are likely to be neat and orderly, and to keep your environment well-organized. Your ruling planet is Mercury, also the asteroids, and you are therefore a good conversationalist, with a wide-ranging knowledge and interesting ideas. You are likely to have a youthful appearance. You love work and service to others, and the gathering of the fruits of the material world (symbolized by the harvest). Virgo people have a reputation for neatness which can border on obsession, and for nervousness and a concern over issues of health. You are perhaps overly analytical and fond of detail, with perfectionist tendencies. You may miss out on the big picture, by concentrating on the micro. You should also beware of being overly critical. You may project yourself to others as though you had an inferiority complex, but another way to look at this is that you possess an innate sense of humility, which is one of the great spiritual lessons, that of humble service. The mission of Virgo is the purification of its activity in pursuit of its goals, the inherent love of excellence in all strivings.

Mercury in conjunction (within 2.6 degrees) with Ascendant Ruler of rising sign

The strongest blend of the energies represented by these two planets.

This conjunction gives a personality who values mental pursuits and communication highly. You have a need to connect with other people. Your logical and communicative abilities are excellent. You are quick-witted and glib, and may also be nervous and high-strung. If your Mercury is in the twelfth House, you may be more subdued, tending to reflect internally before speaking, rather than continually reaching out to other people. In either a First House or a Twelfth House placement, you may feel the urge to dominate any conversation you enter into. Your pride in your mental abilities and education may overshadow your ability to hear other people. You may turn to writing or public speaking as a way to share your enthusiasm for your own ideas. You are in essence an independent thinker with your own way of looking at things, and you may be inspired and even visionary in your outlook.

Mars in weak trine (within 7.1 degrees) with Ascendant

The planetary energies flow smoothly; the connection is easy and beneficial.

This aspect gives an active, out-going and self-confident personality. You are daring and have great physical vitality and stamina. You are likely to possess a wiry and spare physique. You are also probably athletic and hard working, perhaps argumentative, and you can definitely "hold your own" in a dispute. You may be so independent that you seem not to care for the opinion of anyone else! Your confidence, independence and will power inspire others, but you should beware of abrasive behavior towards them, such as bragging or pushing yourself too much. You should instead try for much-needed physical activity as an outlet for your abundant energy.

Pluto in weak conjunction (within 6.5 degrees) with Ascendant

The strongest blend of the energies represented by these two planets.

This conjunction gives a willful personality with a focus on being recognized and admired. You like to get your way. You have strong desires, and are single-minded about pursuing them. You have a powerful urge toward self-transformation, and may go through many changes in your life. In relationships, you tend to become intensely involved quickly, and stay absorbed in the relationship as long as it lasts. You are not shy about expressing your beliefs, and may feel a compulsion toward self-assertion and self-aggrandizement. You tend to overpower any situation, perhaps owing to underlying feelings of insecurity leading to rather self-centered and ego-oriented behavior. This behavior can change, however, for you have tremendous powers of regeneration and rebirth. You tend to champion the underdog, and react strongly to social injustice. When you learn to train your considerable energy on socially oriented rather than purely personal goals, you can become a focal point for the transformation of society.

Mercury in strong square (within 1.9 degrees) with Midheaven

The planetary energies conflict; internal and creative tensions bring rich rewards through effort over time.

This aspect gives a mentally active personality, who is very involved in mental pursuits. You are a good communicator, and a gifted thinker and organizer, who can use these abilities in your professional life to great advantage. You also like variety, and may be changeable and somewhat unstable in the pursuit of your goals. You may also have great ego-investment in your mental abilities, and benefit from an attempt to cultivate humility in your dealings with others.

Mercury in sextile (within 3.4 degrees) with Neptune

The planetary energies flow together, open into new possibilities, new connections. This aspect gives a clever and imaginative personality with subtle charm. You are visionary and poetic, and quite possibly possess great personal magnetism. You are likely to be an inspired thinker, and may excel in literary accomplishments, especially poetry or fantasy, or perhaps in the visual arts. With a strong connection between your conscious and unconscious mind, you think in terms of symbols rather than logical connections. You are fond of education, but you may miss out on serious study because of your dreaminess and lack of focus. Your imagination is strong, almost to the point of deception; you may tend to confuse illusions with reality, or over-glamorize the object of your ideals. You can profit from learning greater discrimination in your thought process, which will allow you to reap the full benefit and inspiration of your marvelous gift.

Mercury in conjunction (within 3.9 degrees) with Pluto

The strongest blend of the energies represented by these two planets.

This conjunction gives a sharp and penetrating mind, together with unusually clear and direct communication skills. You are likely to be quite interested in the occult, or other hidden and potentially taboo areas of thought. As a matter of fact, you tend to see into the deeper aspects of any subject matter that you might single out for study, and are able to discourse forcefully upon it. You may however become so focused on the emotional charge with which you hold these ideas that you lose a certain sense of perspective regarding them. In other words, you can be compulsively attached to your communication

or the results of your mental process, so that there is a danger that you may feel yourself to be correct in what you say, in spite of what others may think. You might also need to be aware of a tendency to be manipulative in your dealings with other people, since you have a forceful will in association with your powers of speech and communication. Other Natal Planets

Venus in Leo (0° Leo 32') - Venus in the Eleventh House

Venus in Leo gives a proud and willful love nature that is also loyal and affectionate. With this placement you are dramatic and dignified, and at the same time very caring and compassionate. You are a seeker for pleasure and are given to the grand gesture in the expression of your affection. Your values are definitely your own, and you make a work of art out of your presentation of yourself to the world at large. You are likely to be quite attractive. You are warm-hearted and spontaneous but knowing so well what you want, you also can be very controlled in the expression of your relationship energy. You love society in the sense of the impact that you make upon it, and benefit from pulling back and considering other points of view as equally valid to your own.

Venus in the Eleventh House represents a strong connection within you between artistic sensibility, your values, and group associations or ideals. You are very interested in group consciousness and in the betterment of society at large. If you possess artistic ability such as music, poetry or painting, it is likely to express itself in this area. You may find that you function better in friendships and acquaintanceships than you do in close partnerships. Your love and affection may communicate itself more directly in the general and all-inclusive vision of societal connection rather than with any particular person, even your significant other. You benefit from practicing a greater degree of discrimination in the choices you make regarding your associations. You may be inclined to spiritual group studies or philanthropic activities. You have an idealistic vision for the integration of society into a more unified whole that drives your basic approach to life.

Jupiter in Libra (26° Lib 24') - Jupiter in the Second House

Jupiter in the Second House (or sign) gives you a deep appreciation of your home environment and the material side of your existence. You are likely to possess luxuries and the good things of life, which come to you without your even having to try very hard. You have the gift for making money. You are also likely to be very sensual in your appreciation of the finer things that life has to offer. You have an ease with the practicalities of life that many would envy. You are also likely to be fond of good food and your waistline may have a tendency to expand. You rarely take chances, and are so secure in your material well-being that you seem not to emphasize this factor, being more interested in personal and cultural values.

Jupiter in Libra (or the seventh house) gives you a refined and idealistic nature. You are easily influenced by others, and may have great difficulty in making a decision, especially when you start to take into consideration all of the possibilities that suggest themselves to

you. You work well with other people, and are known for your fairness. You will always champion both sides of a dispute and make sure that the underdog has his say. You are thoughtful and diplomatic and make a good lawyer. You are also likely to be very social and attractive to others. Other people matter to you in an extraordinary way, which can be both a blessing and a curse. You are a great lover of art and beauty wherever you find it, but you may tend to scatter your focus, and could benefit from more firmly concentrating your energies to serve your own inner motivation.

Saturn in Sagittarius (19° Sag 08'R) - Saturn in the Fourth House

Saturn in the Fourth House (or sign) gives a deepening and concentrating, or a blockage in the expression of the feelings. You may seem to be rigid and unemotional, or emotionally unavailable. You can be apt to withdraw from too close emotional involvement. You may have had problems with parental care and guidance in your early years, so that your home and family life is quite important to you, but you may feel the need to escape it. You potentially have a fixation with one or both parents, and a tendency to live in the past, and you need to work through your issues in this area. Security is very important, and may take the form of striving for achievement or material rewards. You may display a tendency to introversion. You may also have strong psychic powers. Your lesson is to more fully and deeply understand and value your true origins, leading to a better sense of security and greater self-acceptance. Saturn in Sagittarius (or the ninth house) gives an educated and philosophically active mentality, with a deepening and a concentration, or a blockage, in the area of higher learning and expansion into new horizons. You are courageous in expressing your opinion, have a keen intuition and make a good teacher. Your early beliefs may be characterized by adhering too strictly to a dogmatic and rigid set of principles, but you grow into a more mature wisdom in your later years. You likely have a need for physical exercise. You make a good teacher, and may also feel a calling to work with the disadvantaged. While open and honest, and intent on expressing your point of view, you may also doubt yourself in this area, seeming indecisive or rebellious. Your goals are mental and spiritual, rather than material, and you may search for a new framework of moral or spiritual values, rather than adopt existing outworn belief systems. Your lesson is to eventually come to the realization that the true source of moral and ethical valuation lies within yourself.

Uranus in Leo (12° Leo 42') - Uranus in the Twelfth House

Uranus in the Twelfth House gives an understanding and helpful personality. With this placement you may feel some confinement or restriction in your freedom to be who you want to be. Your intuition is strong. You are inclined to nervousness, and perhaps may suffer from over sensitivity. Inner goals are more important for you than conventional ones. You are restless and not entirely at home in the physical plane, and may seek relief in drugs or other forms of escapism. You have an intense desire to commune more directly with the divine within you that does not easily find its realization in mundane activities. You are likely also to be psychically in tune with others, and you may have an interest in

mysticism or the occult. You are dedicated to the service of humanity at large, and these ideals will strongly affect the expression of your individuality. You may have a need to confront the past in order to outgrow its effects on your own life, manifested in terms of subconscious or habitual patterns.

Chiron in Aquarius (19° Aqu 59'R) - Chiron in the Sixth House

Chiron in the Sixth House (or sign) represents issues with one's vital force of improving and organizing more efficient ways to serve self and others. With this placement you are more or less compulsively drawn to the issues of organization, and personal sickness and health, as well as service to other people. You may experience some degree of suffering through ill-health, either real or imagined, or through over-doing for others in a service role, perhaps as a member of an organization or work place. You may experience painful realizations around the possibility of perfection in this life time, such as keeping the perfect house in order at all times, so that it becomes an obsession, or the quest for the perfect body. These issues may stem from early childhood, in relation to being put in a position of servitude against your will, or challenged in your developing feelings of selfworth, so that issues of making yourself available to others become both a habit and a source of painful memories in your adult life. Or these issues may operate more at the level of the fantasy and the imagination. It is important to get as conscious as possible with these issues, to discover what actual events may have been essential to forming the constellation of your inner life. As long as these issues remain locked away your unconscious they are basically toxic to your healthy self-image, and they backfire on you when you least expect them to, and may eventually manifest as actual ill-health. As you become more conscious of these patterns deep within you the healing can begin, enabling you to be of true service to others, as you operate from a place of joy and well-being, rather than from a place of resentment and frustration. By doing this work on yourself, you get more clear, and you gain a truer perspective on yourself and your life's journey. As you are better able to nourish yourself with what you actually need, you are better able to help others as well.

The following applies to your generation as a whole as well as to you personally:

Chiron in Aquarius represents issues with one's vital force to belong, to function as part of a group consciousness, and to integrate with the human family. With this placement, you may be vulnerable to losing your personal identity to a group cause or belief system. You are both attracted to membership in groups or social organizations and have somewhat painful realizations surrounding these types of activities. It may be that membership in a group or "in-crowd" was denied you in your youth. It may be that parental influences or the influence of a parental-like authority figure tended to force you in a particular direction that you had no real calling for, perhaps the common ideals of consensus reality, and you were left with the painful decision of which to abandon, your parental guidepost, or your own true self. In time you can come to yourself as you begin placing more importance on creating interpersonal friendships which are true to your actual ideals rather than the common ideals of the collective. It takes time to develop the understanding of who we really are at a deep level. It may be the only worthwhile undertaking. At any rate you are one who is particularly called to work out your own future, to become truly self determined, independent of the strictures of society. It is possible that you are truly called to become an exemplar of a particular group ideal that is just breaking into the awareness of the world at large; your path may be to quite uniquely go where no (wo)man has gone before. This can be a lonely road, and you may find that it takes many trials and tribulations along the way before you begin to realize your true potential. It is not surprising that someone with such a mission in life might quail before the prospect, and there are undoubtedly great feelings of ambivalence you will have to deal with, especially in your early years, while you are still evolving. The gold at the end of this particular rainbow is worth the effort.

North Node in Libra (24° Lib 02'R) in the Second House

Lunar North Node in the Second House (or sign). South Node in the eighth house or sign. This placement gives a personality somewhat focused around the issues of money and material possessions. In a previous period, or past lifetime, you were concerned with the utilization of other people's resources rather than your own. You also may have gotten involved with occult practices, or engaged in deep and even taboo relations with others, factors that shaped your past, and the residue of which still colors your present life experience. Now, in this lifetime, you must learn to marshal your own forces and be a resource unto yourself. You are in the process of clarifying your values, based on a new feeling of independence, having come through the fires of hell, as it were, in order to establish a more stable and lasting sense of self-worth.

Lunar North Node in Libra (or the seventh house). South Node in the first house or sign. This placement gives a personality with a focus on forming close partnership attachments. You may have difficulties in marriage and partnerships; but there are also great rewards to be gained in this area. This is ultimately a spiritual placement of the North Node. In the past, or in past lives, you have been concerned with yourself alone, but now you must make the transition to being mostly concerned with others. This concern for the other person does not come naturally to you, for it is easier to rely on yourself, as you have always done. Now, in this lifetime, though, you need to focus your energies outward. The welfare of the other person, your intimate partner or your partner in other types of relationship, is a necessary key to your own spiritual evolution. By fulfilling this mission of connection with others, you enrich your own experience, so that you come back to yourself more whole, more well rounded. Your lessons in this life revolve around this ideal of true giving of yourself to another.

Other Aspects

Venus in strong square (within 1.8 degrees) with Neptune

The planetary energies conflict; internal and creative tensions bring rich rewards through effort over time.

This aspect gives a charming, generous and idealistic personality. You are likely to have an intense love of beauty and the arts, especially music and painting, and an interest in spiritual matters. You are imaginative and visionary, also compassionate and kind, and are extremely sensitive to the suffering of other people. You can give a great deal without expecting anything in return; you may even feel a sense of obligation to give to other people. You dream of finding the perfect relationship partner, but you may encounter difficulties in making that dream a reality. You can also become enmeshed in emotional

confusion, which may lead to your depending too much on the strength of another person. You benefit from developing a more discriminating attitude toward relationships generally and more confidence in the value of your own process.

Saturn in strong sextile (within 0.8 degrees) with Chiron

The planetary energies flow together, open into new possibilities, new connections. With this aspect, you may have a tendency be rigid or stuck in situations; unbending. You have an attachment and also great difficulty with authority. You may have suffered through potentially painful experiences as a child, when you were forced to submit to an arbitrary authority or limitation of some kind. The relationship with your father may have been damaged in some way; perhaps it was a relationship you had to get away from, either from his overbearing nature or from his neediness and lack of presence. With this aspect, you need to make your own form of personal authority, independent from the parental influences or that of society. This gives you the potential for great strength and leadership, if you can integrate your powerful and perhaps repressed emotions regarding your concept of authority. In this way you can become an exemplar for others. You may be one to rework the structure of society itself in some way, or to become an advisor or even a leader in the social sphere; perhaps in connection with organizations devoted to new age healing techniques.

Pluto in strong square (within 2.0 degrees) with Midheaven

The planetary energies conflict; internal and creative tensions bring rich rewards through effort over time.

This combination gives a forceful personality with a strong and difficult focus on issues of authority, power and control. There may in fact be a compulsion for control manifesting in problems with interpersonal relations or in rebellious attitudes toward established authority, or perhaps in the charismatic personal magnetism of the born leader. You tend to seek to be in a position of authority. There are however likely to be problems inherent in maintaining a position of authority, once achieved. What is needed is a reevaluation and transformation of the urge for power and control, based on a deeper understanding of personal power and a more conscious and socially responsible use of it.

Venus in square (within 4.1 degrees) with Jupiter

The planetary energies conflict; internal and creative tensions bring rich rewards through effort over time.

This aspect gives a graceful and refined nature. You are naturally attractive, although you should beware of a tendency toward vanity or idleness. You are restless and like an element of change and adventure. You have an appreciation or talent for literature and the arts, and also work well in fields such as the law, or other work with the public. You should beware of being too easily influenced by others.

Venus in semi-sextile (within 1.2 degrees) with Pluto

The planetary energies attract each other, require effort, allow entry of new information. This aspect gives a magnetic personality with a focus on forming close emotional attachments. You are charismatic and intense, and seek to break through any barriers to close interpersonal relationships, although you may be difficult to satisfy emotionally. There are some problems to be worked out in this area, which may lead you to a painful reexamination of your goals. Wisdom is required in the way you handle close relationships, in order to transform the partnership energy into a growing and conscious act of sharing.

Venus in sextile (within 3.2 degrees) with Midheaven

The planetary energies flow together, open into new possibilities, new connections. This aspect gives a caring and aesthetically motivated personality. You are friendly and social, and consistently strive for harmony in your dealings with other people. With the beauty and grace of Venus affecting your public life, you are ideally suited for a career in diplomacy or the arts, or some other elegant and graceful profession, such as interior decorating. You work well with others, and do better to establish yourself in a business partnership rather than being employed on your own.

Mars in square (within 2.7 degrees) with Uranus

The planetary energies conflict; internal and creative tensions bring rich rewards through effort over time.

This aspect gives an individual with an original and eccentric mind, whose intuition is strong. You are a strong-willed nonconformist, and totally have your own code of ethics. You are energetic and visionary in your outlook. You may be rebellious at times, or display fits of temper. You can be quite rash and impulsive. You are also restless and may lack steadiness in the pursuit of your goals. You may feel a sense of isolation, and can appear emotionally insensitive at times, seemingly more excited by ideas than by other people. Your basis for action derives from a sense of high ideals, rather than from mere egotism. You also could beware, however, of a tendency to be dogmatic, or proud and unbending. Change and variety excite you, and your mutability and urge for constant change can frustrate or confuse those around you. In essence, you are a courageous and pioneering free spirit, whose mission in life is to bring new ideas into being. You can benefit from bringing more consciousness and clarity to the expression of your goals in life.

Sun in weak square (within 7.7 degrees) with Mars

The planetary energies conflict; internal and creative tensions bring rich rewards through effort over time.

This aspect gives a rash personality with a quick temper. You are daring and have great physical vitality and stamina, but you may lack patience and tend to be argumentative. You are likely to be restless with a forceful drive that can lead you to accomplish great things, if properly harnessed. You are also likely to be excitable, and tend to run risks. You can be opinionated. You could also be hard to talk with at times, since you have a tendency to take your own position at the expense of the others. You mean well, but it may not turn out that way in the event. You need to temper your strong physical drive with calmness and judgment.

Sun in weak conjunction (within 10.4 degrees) with Uranus

The strongest blend of the energies represented by these two planets.

This conjunction gives an eccentric and strong-willed individual. You can be determined to get your own way, and you love freedom from conventionality. You may be inclined to recklessness. You have a strong need to rebel against the norm, and you may conflict with

others in this area. Because you are unpredictable at times, and your consciousness is always changing, it can be hard for others to be completely comfortable with you. You are an original and independent thinker with an active, scientific mind, futuristic in outlook, and are capable of bringing new ideas into being. You are also inclined to be nervous and impatient, and you may tend to shy away from commitment and responsibility. You can benefit from harnessing your energetic and visionary impulses in order to make these more concretely available in your own life, and in the life of society around you.

Sun in weak conjunction (within 8.6 degrees) with Pluto

The strongest blend of the energies represented by these two planets.

This conjunction gives a willful personality with a focus on being recognized and admired. You like to get your way; you have strong desires, and are single-minded about pursuing them. You also have a powerful urge toward self-transformation, and you may go through many changes in your life. You are not shy about expressing your beliefs, and you may even feel a compulsion toward self-assertion or self-aggrandizement. You also tend to champion the underdog, and react strongly to social injustice. In relationships, you tend to become intensely involved quickly, and stay absorbed in the relationship as long as it lasts. There may be underlying feelings of insecurity leading to your rather self-centered and ego oriented behavior. These feelings must be explored more consciously, or else they will continue to haunt you from beneath your level of awareness. Such an exploration can be incredibly rewarding for you, and should be quite possible, for you have tremendous powers of regeneration and rebirth. When you learn to train your considerable energy on these socially oriented as well as personal goals, you can become a focal point for the transformation of society itself.

Mars in weak square (within 4.6 degrees) with Chiron

The planetary energies conflict; internal and creative tensions bring rich rewards through effort over time.

With this aspect you have issues around expressing anger, as well as exerting personal will versus knuckling under to authority. You have enormous energy and endurance at your disposal. It may be that you have had many painful experiences with violence, or potential violence, on the part of someone close to you, perhaps in your early childhood. As a result of these experiences, you may fear the power of your own anger, and seek to placate your opponent in situations where a direct confrontation seems to be brewing. This aspect is the hallmark of a "passive-aggressive" attitude, in which there is hidden aggression under-expressed, rather than any form of direct attack. In fact, it is said that those with this aspect are often very good at eliciting angry behavior from others, while their own hands stay clean. This is because those people you come into close contact with may become the projection point for your own hidden violent feelings that you are failing to directly express yourself. It is often the case that the powerful emotions associated with this aspect hover below the level of conscious awareness in your psyche. As you become more aware of these patterns, you will less and less need to act them out either suppressed with passivity, or with bluster. Another manifestation of this aspect, perhaps paradoxically, is the ability to lead and be willful, to not take "no for an answer", to be ruthless in accomplishing one's aims. The willful energy of Mars is given a creative boost by Chiron, both in terms of suffering and in a better-integrated personality, in terms of

conquest. A still better level of integration produces the self-assured and powerful personality who does not depend on others either to express his or her own desires, nor to be crushed by them.

Jupiter in quintile (within 1.7 degrees) with Uranus

The planetary energies are positively linked, subtle, and spiritual in dimension.

This combination gives a socially conscious, optimistic and intuitive individual who works well with groups. You have a strong sense of optimism and possess high ideals. You are inventive and original, and are able to motivate others by your example. You like to explore new horizons, either real or imagined, and do not value security on a personal level. You have an incredibly strong intuition, and you do well when you follow your original impulse. You are humane and just, and have high principles, but you should beware of your capacity to envision possibilities too vast to achieve. You can benefit from cultivating a more practical approach.

Jupiter in weak sextile (within 5.3 degrees) with Pluto

The planetary energies flow together, open into new possibilities, new connections. This combination gives a positive and determined personality, with an ability to develop your powers to the fullest. You are inclined to transform yourself in the course of a lifetime. You have good judgment, and a constant sense of what is important to you. Your focus is excellent, and you make a good leader because of it. You work well in the area of interpersonal relationships, although you should beware of a tendency to dominate others. You may be interested in the occult, or possess the powers of a healer or mystic. Your best use of your powers of focus and self-transformation are in the area of working with other people, for you have much to share with your fellow-man.

Jupiter in weak trine (within 6.4 degrees) with Chiron

The planetary energies flow smoothly; the connection is easy and beneficial.

With this placement you have a strong connection with spirituality and a great tendency to go your own way rather than subserve yourself to the spiritual ideals of human consciousness. You also may have been wounded in your spirituality in some way; perhaps in your early life you were forced into relationship with some sort of spiritual community to which you did not feel a connection. These two planetary energies, Jupiter and Chiron, both have a strong spiritual component, but operate in different ways. With Jupiter's optimism in support of Chiron's tendency for pain and suffering as a way toward the light, you are always able to rise above distressing circumstances, buoyed up by a strong streak of faith in the ultimate beneficence of Spirit. In fact, positive outlooks can become something of an obsession with you, so that friends and associates get tired of your unflagging optimism even though you are such a helpful companion. You have an abiding interest in matters of the religion and philosophy, although this is likely to represent your own style of spiritual involvement rather than any standard form of spiritual institutions.

Saturn in weak trine (within 6.5 degrees) with Uranus

The planetary energies flow smoothly; the connection is easy and beneficial.

This aspect gives a practical yet future-oriented personality. You are definitely not a conformer. You have a strong imagination and good conceptual level. When you function at your best you have the capability to bring a concrete and real-world practicality to the intangible and visionary Uranian energy. Your dynamic is to move from knee-jerk reactions either for or against established authority toward establishing your own personal authority, in your own way, in order to make your brilliant visionary impulses available to society at large.

Neptune in inconjunct (within 1.5 degrees) with Midheaven The planetary energies do not flow smoothly, one or the other predominates; discrimination must be employed.

This combination gives a charming personality with an idealistic and deceptive nature. You may have a musical career or achieve much in the helping professions, although you will have to work at it. You are susceptible to suggestion, and you tend to give more than you receive in your employment. You may have a tendency to avoid responsibility. There may have been difficulties or confusion in your early years, especially with regard to the parental care you received at the time, and this issue can spill over into your adult life, when you may confuse others around you by your own lack of clarity. In vocation, you must learn to spell out your goals. You will not be content with most ordinary jobs, until you seek out some part of it that represents a real calling for you. At your best you express the societal ideals of brother- and sisterhood and find a spiritual joy in your work.

The Elements and Modes

The Elements are the fundamental building blocks of Astrology. Each sign corresponds to one or another of the four elements. The signs each have also their own modality, Cardinal, Fixed or Mutable. These are known as the modes of operation of the Element involved, be it Fire, Earth, Air or Water. The combination of the four Elements and the three Modes gives the twelve Astrological signs.

In TimePassages, scores are assigned to the Elements and Modes as follows: The Rising, Sun and Moon sign count two each, while the MC and all the other planets, including Chiron, count one, making a total of sixteen.

Lacking in Water

Desire for emotional fulfillment.

You miss out on the feeling level of situations, preferring to deal with the world in terms of logic. In other words, you leave your heart behind for your head. It may be that you therefore do not easily reach out to others around you, or seem insensitive to the needs and point of view of others. You are attracted to the emotional availability you perceive in others, and long to emulate it. Aware of your basic lack of feeling tone and sensitivity, you are one who will likely work on yourself to become more emotionally present in the course of your lifetime. As you mature, you may well take on many of these qualities that you have been attracted to in others.
